I apologize for just getting back to you. Anyway, the Mobile Consulate will be in Dodge City on March 18th and 19th and they would like to find at least 5 financial institutions/organizations to talk about the following (these are just ideas):

- How to obtain my ITIN?
- Identity and credit theft
- Home loans
- Business loans
- Income tax filing

The workshops would take place while people are waiting to receive their documents. People are usually sitting in a waiting area as a group. They expect to have 170 individuals on Saturday, March 18th and 50 on Sunday March 19th. Also, if the organizations do not have Spanish presenters, the consulate staff would be available to translate. Here are the hours of operation:

- Saturday, March 18th 9:00 am – 5:30 pm
- Sunday, March 19th 10:00 am – noon

Hello Ernestor!

I hope that all is well down there in Dodge City, and that you are enjoying these last 2016 days.

As you know, on March 18 and 19 we will be having our first 2017 Mobile Consulate in Dodge City, coincidentally on that same week we will be kicking off our “Semana de la Educación Financiera 2017”. The purpose is to create awareness, promote financial education of Mexicans living abroad, and foster the inclusion of these communities in the financial system, as well as reaching out to local financial institutions in order to present them with the security features of our passports and MCAs (an issue that we are aware has gained importance in that area).

As such we are looking into the possibility of inviting local financial institutions or organizations to provide information and workshops on these topics during our Mobile Consulate. So far we are still in the planning phase, and have considered inviting people from the local offices of H&R Block and Nationwide Insurances, as we have collaborated with their KC offices in the past, and are still exploring which banks would it be beneficial to involve.

I just wanted to let you know about these plans, in case you had any proposal or advice regarding the activities we could plan.

I am attaching the calendar of events we had last year, so you may have a general idea of some of the topics addressed. As you will notice, most of our activities were held at the Mexican Consulate in KC, however we are trying to change this and be more involved with our community in the rest of our jurisdiction.

The City of Dodge City has received phone calls from concerned citizens about U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) being in our community. The City has verified that ICE was in Dodge City this past week. The purpose of their visit was to arrest specific individuals that were wanted for previous felonies or had deportation orders. This visit is not in contradiction to Chief Drew Francis' statement that was issued previously in regards to Executive Order signed by President Trump.

La Ciudad de Dodge City ha recibido llamadas de ciudadanos preocupados por la presencia de agentes de Inmigración y Control de Aduanas (ICE) en nuestra comunidad. La Ciudad ha verificado que ICE estuvo en Dodge City durante esta semana. El propósito de su visita fue buscar y detener a personas específicas que han cometido una felonía previa o tienen una orden de deportación. La visita de los agentes de ICE no contradice la declaración del jefe de policía Drew Francis que fue publicada anteriormente con referencia a la acción ejecutiva firmada por el Presidente Trump.
