Wednesday, February 16, 2011 – 1:00 pm
Dodge City Civic Center – 2110 First Ave.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Ryan Ausmus.

Members present: Ryan Ausmus, Debra Muylaert, Marilyn Treto, Oliver Bland and Sara Mora. Absent were Greta Clark, Elva Dominguez, and Randy Smith. Micaela Morales no longer works for the Chamber and a new representative will be requested. Guests: Mohammad Abdurahman, Charles Sellens, Kerry Shapiro, Luanne Menard, Vernon Bogart and Adan Abdulkadir.

On a motion by Debra, seconded by Marilyn, the minutes were approved.

Old Business:

1. **Multicultural luncheon** was well attended. Mo's presentation on understanding refugee and asylum status was very beneficial for those attending.
2. **CDBG Grant.** It was announced that the City received a housing rehab grant in the amount of \$266,000. Vernon asked what guarantees were there that the improvements would be maintained to proper standards once the work was completed. Sara stated that the lunch was a business buy-in to our mission but that the scheduled cleanups draw people together. Mo spoke on the need to promote neighbor helping those in need.
3. **Cleanup dates.** Suggested dates are April 9 & 16 from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm.

New Business:

1. Debbie Allen was not able to attend to discuss the grant for a community center.
2. Kerry Shapiro works with the Dean of Technology. She is working on a \$300,000 EPA grant that would provide job training in sustainable green jobs such as OSHA hazwopper, lead abatement, solid waste, freon removal, etc. The grant is due March 18. Kerry was asking for input on ideas.
3. The Main Street Dodge City Multicultural Festival was discussed. The committee would be interested in participating once more information is provided.
4. Deb will check with businesses regarding cost of polo/t-shirts for board members to wear when participating in community events.

Comments from Board Members: Ryan will be attending Hispanic Day on the Hill in Topeka Feb. 23rd.

Comments from Attendees. Vernon Bogart spoke about his idea on the purpose of the Advisory Board. He stated that we need to get to the root of the problem regarding the community being divided before we can fix the problem. Our Board has to reach out to solve the problem from the inside out.

Board members stated that they believe the neighborhood cleanups are an important way to bridge the conflict.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
