7. The Dodge City Fire Department sent their Certified Fire

Investigators to the annual Kansas Chapter of the International Association of Arson Investigators Conference last week in Wichita Ks. DCFD Fire Investigators are required to obtain 20 hours of continuing education each year in order to keep their State Certification. Areas covered in this year's training were current standards and job performance requirements, fire investigation law including current search and seizure issues related to arson investigations in the State of Kansas and new techniques in using fire dynamics analysis to assist investigators in finding the origin of fire and explosions. Fire Investigators from all over the United States attend this conference because of the excellent training that is provided by the KSIAAI and world renowned instructors from the fire investigation industry that teach these continuing education courses.

Full Time

CVB Tourism Coordinator

Rate of Pay: \$17.04 - \$26.40

The position is responsible for marketing Dodge City to leisure travelers, group tour operators, conventions, travel writers, and others. Duties include representing Dodge City in a friendly and helpful manner; supporting and aiding in the implementation of the CVB overall strategy and marketing plan; hosting site visits; making arrangements for overnight visiting groups, conventions, and trade shows; planning and coordinating ads, calendars, websites, and maintaining CVB social media. Required: • Associates Degree in marketing, communications or business or a combination of education and job experience equivalent to such; • Valid Kansas Class C Driver's License. • Good driving record. • Minimum of two (2) years' experience related to marketing, customer service, public relations and/or graphic design.

AFM Maintenance Worker I

Rate of Pay: \$12.13 - \$17.87

Athletic Field Maintenance Worker I will perform manual labor in grounds keeping and maintenance of sports facilities, turf, maintenance of equipment, and other duties as assigned. Duties require ability to professionally interact with citizens and to operate various types of equipment including mowers, power and hand tools, and trimmers. Weekend hours required during summer ball season, with overtime potential. This job requires physical work including lifting and manipulating up to 50 lbs., and performing these duties in all types of weather. Preference for someone with turf maintenance and/or turf sprinkler irrigation experience. Requires a minimum of one year of grounds maintenance and customer service experience, a valid Kansas driver's license and a good driving record.

Police Support Services Technician

Rate of Pay: \$12.14 - \$18.75

Under general supervision, the Support Services Technician position is responsible for assisting officers with retrieval of information from databases; large volume of data entry; filing; and communicating, reviewing and maintaining records and reports. Position involves serving the public in a professional manner by communicating effectively to determine individual needs. Bilingual skills preferred but not required. Position requires High School diploma or equivalency. Ability to operate a computer and related software along with standard office equipment is required. Acceptable candidates must undergo an extensive background investigation, substantial testing, polygraph exam, physical exam and must be a U.S. Citizen. Post background check, a clerical and typing test is required with a minimum score of 35 wpm on the typing test.

Police Officer

Rate of Pay: \$36,844 - \$54,141

Under general supervision, Police Officers patrol an assigned beat and investigate incidents in the enforcement of law and order in the protection of life and property. Applications will be used to fill current vacancies and to form an eligibility list for future reference. Qualifications and requirements: High School diploma or GED, U.S. Citizenship, 21 years of age, no felony convictions or domestic violence history or convictions, valid driver's license and good driving record. (See Grounds for Disqualification and job description on the City web site www.dodgecity.org/jobs.asp) Law enforcement experience is not a requirement for a new recruit.

Utilities Maintenance Worker I

Rate of Pay: \$12.13-\$17.87

Utilities Maintenance Worker will repair, maintain and perform minor construction of the water and sewer systems within the City of Dodge City. Duties will include, but are not limited to, installation of hydrants and services, repair of water lines, rodding sewers, maintaining wells, cleaning and maintaining equipment, daily service work and meter reading. Position has some interaction with the public, so good customer service skills are required. After a training period, utilities maintenance workers may be eligible for on-call duties, qualifying them for extra duty pay. These jobs require physical work including lifting and manipulating up to 75 lbs., and performing these duties in all types of weather. A valid Kansas driver's license is required with good driving record, and must obtain a Class B CDL with air-brake endorsement within 6 months of hire for all Public Works positions. Position subject to random drug/alcohol testing after CDL is acquired.

Part-Time Transportation Bus Driver

Rate of Pay: \$11.55 - \$17.69

A Temporary PT Bus Driver will operate the City's fixed and para-transit route bus service. Bus Drivers must have excellent customer service skills, possess a valid Kansas driver's license with a clean driving record and a Commercial Drivers' License (CDL) with Passenger Endorsement before date of hire or have ability to acquire such by date of hire. Drivers must be able to pass a background check, a DOT physical, and be available to work between 20-29 flexible weekday hours per week. Hours of operation for the transportation system are weekdays 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Random drug testing performed throughout employment. Bilingual skills preferred but not required.

Regular Part-time Zoo Attendant

Rate of Pay: \$11.00 - \$17.00

Part-time Zoo Attendant will perform routine and semiskilled work in feeding, watering, and general humane care of animals at the Zoo, assists the Zookeeper, and performs work in the general maintenance and cleaning of the Zoo facilities and grounds. Zoology or Animal Science education background preferred. Minimum of two years of experience in the care of animals is required along with good customer service skills. Must be able to lift and manipulate heavy weights (50 lbs. & up) frequently. Regular part-time position works varied daytime hours daily Monday thru Friday and some additional hours on weekends. A valid Kansas driver's license with good driving record is required.






