1. City of Dodge City Employees performed their adopt-a-highway on East Wyatt Earp this morning. Altogether, they picked up 38 bags of litter in the area between Ave B and Road 113 on Wyatt Earp. The CREW Advisory Board performed their adopt-a-



highway on North Ave on Monday, October 14th. Our Lady of Guadalupe performed their adopt-a-highway clean up on north Highway 50 from Kliesen street to the West City Limits on Friday and Saturday, October 18th and 19th. On Saturday, October 19th, the Dodge City Community College International Club will perform their adopt-a-highway on North Highway 50 from Kliesen Street to the East City Limits. We want to thank all of our adopt-a-highway groups for their efforts to help keep Dodge City a beautiful place.

2. Next Saturday at 3 pm on October 26, the 7th Annual Pit Bull Walk for National Pit Bull Awareness Day will take place. To participate, dogs must be registered and insured and be on a 6-foot or shorter leash with no retractable leashes; they must be muzzled and be current on vaccinations. There will also be a police escort to assist with directing traffic as well as ensuring the safety of the animals. Educational materials regarding pit bulls and Breed Specific Legislation will also be available. The walk begins at 3 p.m. at the corner of 4th Avenue and Mulberry Street near Lions Park and will conclude at the Dodge City Visitors Center at Wyatt Earp Boulevard and 3rd Avenue. 3. The Vietnam Memorial Monument was delivered last Thursday and placed Saturday next to the walking trail located northwest of Cavalier Field. Gary Noller, a former Dodge City resident, wanted to recognize three of his former St. Mary High School classmates, James Nufer, Gregg Steimel, and Richard Conrardy, who were lost during the Vietnam War. Gary is in the process of raising funds to help pay for the memorial. A formal dedication ceremony will take place on June 2020.



4. “The Faces of the East Side Neighborhoods Portrait Project” will be displayed in the Santa Fe Depot El Vaquero Dining Room from October 21st through October 25th. The public is welcome to view the project Monday through Friday from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM or during the Depot Theater Company’s Final Fridays in Dodge City event on October 25th from 6:00 PM – 9:00 PM. Sponsored by Humanities of Kansas and the Southwest Kansas Library System, this project was led by Humanities Scholar, Eutimeo ‘Dani’ Sandoval, and portraits were taken by Jasmine Strecker. The “Faces of the East Side” highlights community members whose ancestry dates back to Dodge City’s Mexican Village. “One never forgets their roots, & the ‘Family of Families’ from the East Side share an amazing history, one of mutual respect, & friendship.” This portrait project has previously been displayed at the Carnegie Center for the Arts.
5. Main Street Dodge City held its annual Board of Directors retreat this week. The meeting serves a way of looking at what has been done for the year as well as setting the goals and work plans for the upcoming year. The Board of Directors chose the recipients for this year’s Main Street awards, which will be announced during the Main Street Dodge City Annual Meeting set to take place in November. The streetscape concept was presented to the Board of Directors; this is the same concept that was presented to City Commissioners during an October Work Session.

Staff is finishing the details for the Trick-or-Treat Downtown event next Saturday, October 26th, from 10:30-12:00.

Downtown Clean-up will take place Friday, October 25th 2:30 pm – 4:00 pm to get the downtown area ready for Final Friday as well as Trick-or-Treat Downtown.

6. Parks and Facilities Athletic Field Maintenance staff removed the old flag poles at Hennessy this week. The poles hadn’t been used for years and were in terrible shape.
7. Park staff started work earlier this week on a project to install irrigation at the dog park. The dog park remains closed until further notice.
8. It's only mid-October, but to get all the lights installed in time for the upcoming holidays, Parks and Facilities staff began installing lights downtown on 3rd Ave. this week.
9. Parks and Facilities Forestry/Landscape staff have been busy aerating downtown landscaping beds. Aeration is done to allow air, water, and fertilizer to get into the soil as well as reducing compaction, which helps promote a stronger root system for the grass.



10. Staff from the Dodge City Fire Department and Developments Services and Inspections helped Mollea Wainscott, with the Dodge City Ford County Development Corp., install 46 smoke alarms in 14 homes this week.
11. Assistant City Manager/Public Affairs Melissa McCoy attended the Great Plains Development Annual Banquet and meeting on Thursday evening. Keynote speakers for the banquet included Xan Wedel and Genna Hurd with the University of Kansas Institute for Policy & Social Research. 2019 General Election News

The Ford County Clerk's office is now accepting Applications for Advance ballots to be mailed for the Cities and Schools General Election to be held on November 5, 2019. Ballots will be mailed out October 16, 2019. In order to have a ballot mailed to you, you must fill out an Application for Ballot by Mail. You may download an application from the Clerk's website or you may call our office at 227-4551 and ask that an application be mailed to you. If you have a disability and cannot get out to vote on Election Day, you may be placed on a permanent mail ballot list. Please ask for a permanent application when calling. The Applications must be filled out completely and returned to the Clerk's office. The last day to mail out ballots for the November 5, 2019, election is October 29, 2019.

Advance in Office voting will begin October 17, 2019, in the County Clerk's Office.

Voting hours will be 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday thru Friday; thru November 4, 2019, when in office voting will end at noon.

This year, for the local election, we will have evening voting hours on October 29, 2019 from 9:00 am to 7:00 pm and October 31, 2019 from 9:00 am to 7:00 pm.

There will be a Saturday voting opportunity on Saturday November 2, 2019 from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. also in the County Clerk's office.

The last day to register to vote for the November 5, 2019, election is October 15, 2019. If you have moved or changed your name, you must reregister 21 days before the election. You may download a voter registration card from the Ford County website. You may register to vote online through the Kansas Secretary of State's office or you may call the office and have a registration card mailed to you.
