1. This Saturday at 3 pm on October 26, the 7th Annual Pit Bull Walk for National Pit Bull Awareness Day will take place. To participate, dogs must be registered and insured and be on a 6-foot or shorter leash with no retractable leashes; they must be muzzled and be current on vaccinations. There will also be a police escort to assist with directing traffic as well as ensuring the safety of the animals. Educational materials regarding pit bulls and Breed Specific Legislation will also be available. The walk begins at 3 p.m. at the corner of 4th Avenue and Mulberry Street near Lions Park and will conclude at the Dodge City Visitors Center at Wyatt Earp Boulevard and 3rd Avenue. 2. Main Street Dodge City would like to invite everyone out to the 9th Annual Trick-or-Treat Downtown this Saturday, October 26th, from 10:30 am - 12:00 pm. This year we have over 40 participating downtown businesses and 15 entries for the scarecrow contest. As part of the event, at 11:30 am we will be having \$1 hamburgers for the first 500 people, on Gunsmoke St. between 2nd and 3rd Avenues. Children will have the opportunity to vote for their favorite scarecrow and turn their vote in for a chance to win a bike. The winner will be announced at 12:20 during the hamburger feed and must be present to win. 3. Parks and Facilities Construction staff recently completed the repairs to the Beeson Arboretum Park's bridge and reopened the area, which was closed to the public on September 26th.
4. The installation of the irrigation system at the dog park is complete, and the area is once again open to dogs and their owners. The water fountain will remain off for the season to prevent freeze damage. Thank you for your patience as Parks and Facilities staff worked on this project.
5. "The Faces of the East Side Neighborhoods Portrait Project" will be displayed in the Santa Fe Depot El Vaquero Dining Room through October 25th. The public is welcome to view the project this Friday from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM or during the Depot Theater Company's Final Fridays in Dodge City event on October 25th from 6:00 PM – 9:00 PM. Sponsored by Humanities of Kansas and the Southwest Kansas Library System, this project was led by Humanities Scholar, Eutimeo 'Dani' Sandoval, and portraits were taken by Jasmine Strecker. The "Faces of the East Side" highlights community members whose ancestry dates back to Dodge City's Mexican Village. "One never forgets their roots, & the 'Family of Families' from the East Side share an amazing history, one of mutual respect, & friendship." This portrait project has previously been displayed at the Carnegie Center for the Arts.

8. The Dodge City-Ford County Census 2020 Complete Count Committee continues to educate the community for the upcoming 2020 Census. Census tables were available at the Dodge City High School, Sunnyside Elementary, Dodge City Middle School, Lynn Elementary, Beeson Elementary, and Sacred Heart. We want to thank the USD 443 Administration and CCC members/volunteers for their time and commitment to 2020 Census work in Dodge City and Ford County.
9. The U.S. Census Bureau has launched a national job recruitment campaign as part of efforts to hire 500,000 census takers nationwide (4,500 in Kansas) for the 2020 Census. This week members of the Dodge City Convention & Visitors Bureau, Boot Hill Museum, Western State Bank Expo Center, Hampton Inn & Suites Dodge City, and Cimarron Community Development attended the 2019 Kansas Tourism Conference in Mulvane Kansas. The annual conference brings CVB's, attractions, hotel, dining, and retail attendees from across the state together for two and a half days worth of inspiring speakers, educational sessions, and networking opportunities.

TIAK Banquet Wednesday evening. KDS is a certification program designed to familiarize and furthers one’s knowledge of the State of Kansas, tourism marketing, and leadership. 12. City and Boot Hill Museum staff attended a construction meeting for the Boot Hill Museum expansion project. The project is continuing on schedule. A tour was also taken of the building to see the interior progress.
13. The Rural Education Workforce Alliance (REWA) Board met on October 23. At the meeting, the board received an update on the various grant applications for the University Center as well as upcoming meetings and community coalition building.

14. At the Joint Commission meeting on Monday, October 21, the City of Dodge City and Ford County approved the 2020 “Why Not Dodge” Sales Tax Budget. In addition, they passed an amendment to the agreement for Dodge City Raceway Park with Triple T Promotions and the agreement regarding the Nor-Am project. There was also a discussion regarding fireworks.
15. The Southwest Kansas Problem Gambling Taskforce wants to learn more regarding the awareness and attitudes about gambling in the community. 2019 General Election News

The Ford County Clerk's office is now accepting Applications for Advance ballots to be mailed for the Cities and Schools General Election to be held on November 5, 2019. Ballots will be mailed out October 16, 2019. In order to have a ballot mailed to you, you must fill out an Application for Ballot by Mail. You may download an application from the Clerk's website or you may call our office at 227-4551 and ask that an application be mailed to you. If you have a disability and cannot get out to vote on Election Day, you may be placed on a permanent mail ballot list. Please ask for a permanent application when calling. The Applications must be filled out completely and returned to the Clerk's office. The last day to mail out ballots for the November 5, 2019, election is October 29, 2019.

Advance in Office voting will begin October 17, 2019, in the County Clerk's Office.

Voting hours will be 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday thru Friday; thru November 4, 2019, when in office voting will end at noon.

This year, for the local election, we will have evening voting hours on October 29, 2019 from 9:00 am to 7:00 pm and October 31, 2019 from 9:00 am to 7:00 pm.

There will be a Saturday voting opportunity on Saturday November 2, 2019 from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. also in the County Clerk's office.

The last day to register to vote for the November 5, 2019, election is October 15, 2019. If you have moved or changed your name, you must reregister 21 days before the election. You may download a voter registration card from the Ford County website. You may register to vote online through the Kansas Secretary of State's office or you may call the office and have a registration card mailed to you.

If you have a question about your registration, please call the office at 227-4551 to check on it.

The Dodge City Public Transit will be providing free bus rides to the polls and to early voting on all of the fix routes beginning October 17, 2019, within their hours of service. For para-transit, door-to-door service (only for those with a permanent or temporary disability), please call 877-323-3626 24-hours in advance. Buses do not run on the weekends.
