1. The Dodge City Raceway Park Advisory Board and Community Facility Advisory Board will hold meetings this week. The purpose of the Raceway Park meeting is to update the advisory board on the outcomes of the 2019 season as well as the schedule for the 2020 season. The CFAB board will hear an update on the United Wireless Arena and Boot Hill Casino Resort Conference Center and recommend the 2020 CFAB Organizational Funding Applications for approval by the Joint Commissions.

2. The Engage Dodge class wrapped up their classes this Tuesday with a tour of the historic Santa Fe Depot. A reception was held as well, and the refreshments were provided by the Dodge City Convention and Visitor's Bureau. The course is coordinated by the Cultural Relations Advisory Board and is free to the public. The program is held every year. For more information contact Ernestor De La Rosa at 620-225-8100.



3. A section of W. Trail St will be closed to through traffic from 4th Ave to the south entrance of the Guymon Petro building beginning at 8 am on Thursday, November 7, 2019, and is anticipated to be reopened by the end of the day. The closure is for the installation of a new sign at the Guymon Petro building.

4. The Complete Count Committee continues to educate our community about the 2020 Census. This week's committee members presented at the Dodge City Community College Adult Learning Center. Over 100 students participated, and they are ready to be counted. 5. At Monday night's City Commission meeting, it was proclaimed that Monday, November 11th, 2019 will be honored as Robert L. 'Bob' Hughes day, in conjunction with the national Veteran's Day. The Avenue of Flags will honor Bob Hughes during the Veterans Day ceremonies in recognition for his inspiring patriotism and service to the United States, Kansas, and Dodge City. The ceremony will take place at Maple Grove Cemetery beginning at 10 am on November 11th. Proclamations will be read from Kansas Gov. Laura Kelly and Mayor Brian Delzeit as well as the laying of the wreaths by auxiliaries from the GI Forum, American Legion, the honoring of the Unknown Soldier, and the Vietnam Memorial.

6. Join the City of Dodge City to keep Dodge City beautiful by recycling on Saturday, Nov. 16. Dodge City's Recycling Advisory Board and Community Recycling Environmental Waste (CREW) will be in the Fire Training Center parking lot to accept your recycled products. See the attached flyer for a complete list of items that will be accepted.
7. On Monday, November 4th, Bruce Grover and Bobby Sloan from Imagemakers, the company that was hired to conduct the marketing study for the Convention and Visitors Bureau, shared their findings with about 30 stakeholders in a two- hour session, and again at a one- hour work session with the city commission.

They shared their recommendations and evaluations based on surveys conducted and research made by their team of experts for improving the overall marketing of the history, heritage, and activities of the community.

They compared targeted audiences, comparable cities, logos, tag lines, web sites, and other elements.

A digital audit was completed and included social media, online reviews, Facebook impressions, and other digital pieces.

The general recommendations that were made included taking a fresh look at all foundation pieces, and shifting branding from the 'old west' to the 'wild west,' to modernize, clarify, and simplify our marketing message.

The first order of business in their recommendation was to reposition and rebrand.

The full report will be available on the city website soon.

8. There is only one more block to go on Central Ave. Reconstruction and work is underway. The new water and sewer lines have been installed in the 800 block and dirt work is currently taking place. This block and the Cedar St. intersection will be a little different as brick pavers have to be installed since this block is in the historic area. The Contractor plans place the remaining curb & gutter at the Cedar St. intersection next week and then work on the intersection. Work will also take place on the curb & gutter, sidewalk, and parking lane of the 800 block. It is anticipated that the Cedar St. intersection should open in late November and the 800 block in December, of course weather may slow the project.



9. On Friday, November 1st, City Staff attended training on Leadership, Team-Building, and Coaching Skills for Managers and Supervisors.



10. Election season has come and gone now for 2019. Many signs were placed in yards and in right-of-ways throughout the campaigning season. Now that the election has passed, the City sign ordinance requires all signs to be removed from yards within one week (November 12, 2019) of Election Day.
11. On November 1-2, the Dodge City Sports Commission hosted the 1A and 2A KSHSAA State Volleyball championships. This was a big event for the DCSC and Dodge City as a whole. It brought in eight teams from each classification and had teams come from as far as Pittsburg and Blue Rapids, KS. Hosting 16 teams at United Wireless Arena on Friday, it was a busy day for everyone that started early in the morning and ran near midnight for the final games.

Friday morning, class 1A started their pool play games at 8:30 a.m. after introductions of all eight teams in the class. The tournament was set up in two four-team pools in which each team played each other, and the top two records moved on to Saturday. In 1A, the final four teams were Central Plains, Rural Vista, Minneola, and Cunningham. Central Plains and Rural Vista played for the championship with Central Plains emerging as the champion.

In the afternoon, class 2A had the same opportunity to play their way into the final four semi-final and championship matches. Garden Plain, the defending champions, made their way to a 3-0 start and found themselves facing Wabaunsee in the semi-final match while Spearville and Valley Heights also made the final four. Wabaunsee and Spearville met in the championship, and Wabaunsee would eventually pull off the 2-1 victory to take home the 2A state title.

Overall, the tournament went very well for the Sports Commission. We will continue to contact teams, coaches, and administration for feedback about the event and the venue in hopes that we can improve on any negative aspects in the future. With this being the first year the DCSC has taken on a state volleyball tournament, we are very pleased with the outcome and only expect a better result in years to come.

1,014 kids trick-or-treat Jackson Hall

Sponsored by United Way of Dodge City, the price of admission was one canned food item per child, which resulted in approximately 1,000 cans of food being collected for the Kansas Soldiers' Home at Fort Dodge.



New Partnership Helps Diesel Tech Students ‘Get Ahead’

DODGE CITY, Kan., November 5, 2019 -- An agreement for a new partnership between DC3 diesel technology and Daimler Trucks North America (DTNA) was approved at the October DC3 Board of Trustees meeting on Tuesday, Oct. 29.

This new partnership, called the Get Ahead Program, is a nationwide cooperative effort between DTNA, participating diesel schools, and DTNA service network locations that offer diesel schools access to Internet-based training free of charge.

In this case, the “diesel school” is DC3, and the “DTNA service network location” is Truck Center Companies (TCC). TCC is one of the nation’s largest full-service Freightliner dealerships with 12 business locations, including one in Dodge City.

The idea for starting the Get Ahead partnership at DC3 originated from a diesel tech advisory board meeting last spring, Colby Kline, DC3 professor of diesel technology, said.

The advisory board is made up of businesses who hire DC3 students and provide needed feedback regarding diesel tech curriculum. And one of the businesses represented on the board is TCC.

“The board helps us in so many ways,” Kline said. “Besides being the businesses who hire our students, they also help us get equipment at reduced rates.”

So, after the advisory board meeting, Kline and the TCC recruiting director, Jim Walsh, began working on the partnership. Part of this collaboration resulted in TCC bringing a new Freightliner truck to campus for Senior Day back in September.

“In a nutshell, students can get access to all the online training that’s available to a professional technician on our Freightliner and Daimler products, while they’re still in college,” Walsh said. “The benefit for a company like ours is we invest thousands and thousands of dollars in training people after they graduate, and it just accelerates our training curve.”

Typically, TCC spends about \$50,000 in training costs for each new technician they hire, Walsh said.

Through the Get Ahead Program, diesel tech students receive access to all the online training that Freightliner technicians get. And if they complete the training, they become system certified for any company who completes warranty work on Daimler products, such as Freightliner, Detroit Diesel, Western Star and Thomas Bus.

In addition, every participating school receives 10 copies of DiagnosticLink for free. DiagnosticLink is a computer-based diagnostic software for Detroit powertrain and Freightliner vehicle systems. It can display engine control unit information, diagnostic fault codes, and instrumentation, as well as run service routines. Jeff Cole, DC3 professor of diesel technology and workforce development chair, said the program definitely puts students a step ahead when they start their jobs, in terms of training. But it also can bring a potential pay bump, he said.

“The strength of this program is students will get job training here at DC3, which is at the same standard as what the industry provides,” Cole said. “The training through this program also will be more up to date than a textbook-based curriculum, because information becomes obsolete so quickly these days due to changes in technology.”

Another bonus to the Get Ahead program is that diesel tech instructors, such as Cole and Kline, can stay current with their certifications more easily.

“I’m excited about the program,” Cole said. “I think it will help open doors for other partnerships, because a lot of companies are begging for good diesel technicians.”
