
1. The Mental Health Task Force, founded in 2016 and comprised of Dodge City Police Department Lt. Colleen Brooks, Dodge City Fire Chief Ken Spencer, Ford County Sheriff Carr, Ford County Fire/EMS Chief Boyd, Deb Moffitt with Family Care Clinic, and Vicki Broz with Compass Behavioral Health, received a \$5,000 grant from the Community Foundation of Southwest Kansas.



This money is earmarked specifically for more training for first responders on taking care of their personal mental health and suicide prevention. While this was a team effort, special thanks goes to Vicki Broz who wrote the grants.

2. City and Development Corporation staff, along with members of the Rural Education Workforce Alliance (REWA) met with representatives of Fort Hays State University about the Bachelor of Nursing program. The program would work similarly to the Bachelor of Social Work Cohort with students obtaining their Associates Degree from Dodge City Community College or one of the regions other community colleges; then completing their bachelor's through a blended mix of face to face and virtual courses. It is anticipated that the program will start in the fall of 2020 and will be housed at Hennessey Hall.

3. A new novel set in Dodge City has recently been published, and it's not just another historical book. This historical fiction novel, *Across Time*, by author Daniel Side, has a detective mystery plot. We tell you about this book because our very own DCPD Lt. Colleen Brooks was one of a handful of Dodge City residents that the author consulted to research for his work.



4. On Wednesday, November 13th, the City held its annual enrollment day at the Hoover Pavilion. Vendors present included: AFLAC, Anytime Fitness, Blue Cross Blue Shield, Census 2020, Dodge City YMCA, KPERS, KPERS 457, LifeSave Transport, United Way, and Western Plains Medical Complex. During this event, all employees can come to renew or change their current insurance plans, talk to vendors about their products, and learn more about the benefits offered as a City employee.



5. On Thursday, November 14th, Renee Rhodes, Risk Control Manager for the Kansas Municipal Insurance Trust (KMIT), was in Dodge City to speak with staff about worker's compensation coverage, and what employees can do to reduce the risk of work-related injuries. Renee also explained how worker's compensation claims are processed and how it can affect the City as a whole.

6. The Dodge City Fire Department completed its annual required Physical Ability Test (PAT). All personnel did very well and made it well below their required time to complete the test. This yearly test assists with fulfilling the fire department's compliance with the National Fire Protection Association 1583 Health and Fitness program for firefighters. This year's best time was accomplished by Firefighter Andrew Kintner with a time of 3:02.



7. Join the City of Dodge City to keep Dodge City beautiful by recycling on Saturday, Nov. 16th. Dodge City's Recycling Advisory Board and Community Recycling Environmental Waste (CREW) will be in the Fire Training Center parking lot to accept your recycled products.

8. Parks and Facilities Forestry/Landscape and Park staff recently completed the annual landscape cleanup. Each fall staff cuts and trims the grass in the landscaped areas to prepare it for next spring's growing season. Staff in these photos are working in the medians along Wyatt Earp.



9. Beginning the morning of Monday, November 18, 2019, Building Solutions LLC will be closing lanes at the Central Ave. and Comanche St. intersection to start on improvements that will finalize the reconstruction project.

Central Ave. will be limited to one lane northbound from Comanche St. to Aspen, with an opening for access through the north Farmer's Market entrance. Comanche St. westbound will be limited to one lane from the Farmers Market entrance to Central Avenue with no right-hand turn access on to Central Ave.

The intersection work is anticipated to take 45 days to complete. Please use caution when traveling in this area of town. For questions or more information, contact Building Solutions at 620-225-1199.

The Dodge City Convention and Visitors Bureau Announces awards Marketing Grants

Dodge City, KS

The Dodge City Convention and Visitors Bureau (CVB) is pleased to announce the approval of four (4) **Marketing Grants, totaling \$7,000**, that will be used for projects promoting Dodge City's attractions and events. Examples of promotional projects may include, Radio, Television, Social Media, Print Media, and other marketing efforts to promote these events. The Grants were reviewed and approved by a Grant Selection Committee, comprised of volunteer members of the Dodge City community.

Grant Recipients for the fall 2019 round of awards are:

- Crop Quest (for the Grower Focus 2020 conference)
- Western State Bank Expo (for Sea Lion Splash)
- Rocking M Media (for Winter EXPO 2020)
- Dodge City/Ford County Development Corporation (for the Rural and Independent Innovators Conference)

These marketing projects will aid in reaching communities in Kansas, (as well as surrounding states), informing them of the activities in Dodge City. The Marketing Grants will be used to market the events for bringing visitors to town and raising awareness of things to do and see, and attractions in the community, with the anticipated result of increasing attendance to events and attractions, growing business for local restaurants and retailers and raising the occupancy in local hotels.

This Marketing Grant was formed in February 2014, to work in tandem with the other locally offered grants through Festivals, Mariah Funds, and Why Not Dodge.

The Grant is available for marketing projects for attractions, venues, or those who hold an event, and are looking to complete a marketing project in Ford County that will attract overnight guests to Dodge City. The Grant is being awarded before the completion of the project with follow-up reporting due after completion. The Grant can cover 80% of the marketing costs, up to \$2,000.00 per project. The Grant deadline was October 31, 2019, and will be available again in the spring of 2020.

The mission of the Convention and Visitors Bureau is to promote Dodge City and the area's resources and assets to bring prospective tourists and convention and business travel to Dodge City. As part of our mission, The Convention and Visitors Bureau aids our attractions and event coordinators in their efforts of getting the word out to prospective visitors to our community and supports the efforts of bringing overnight travel to Dodge City.

All applicants are required to use the "Get the Heck into Dodge" logo, or otherwise recognize the source of the funding in the marketing project.

The Dodge City Convention and Visitors Bureaus' previously awarded Marketing Grants have **totaled nearly \$104,000** and an estimated economic **impact on the community of over 1.9 Million Dollars**. Examples of past Grant Award recipients are Boot Hill Museum; Ford County Fair; Dodge City Area Chamber of Commerce (Dodge City Days); Ford County Historical Society (Mueller-Schmidt House); Dodge City Roundup Rodeo (PRCA Rodeo and other rodeos); Central Station (Dodge City Days Concerts); the Depot Theater, Winter EXPO and other exciting events taking place in Dodge City.

Rotary has been working to end polio for more than 30 years.

As part of the Global Polio Eradication Initiative, Rotary has helped reduce polio cases by 99.9% since the first project to vaccinate children in the Philippines in 1979.



Rotary has helped immunize more than 2.5 billion children in 122 countries. So far, Rotary has contributed more than \$1.8 billion toward eradicating the disease worldwide.

Today, polio remains endemic only in Afghanistan, Nigeria, and Pakistan. But it's crucial to continue working to keep other countries polio-free.
