1. February 13th is quickly approaching, and that means United Express, operated by SkyWest Airlines, will soon take off from Dodge City Regional Airport (DDC) with daily flights to Denver International Airport (DEN). City Staff met with the marketing team from the airline to discuss collaboration efforts and strategies to spread the word of the exciting new jet service to our community and region. You can start booking your travel out of DDC to your final destination through United Airlines at united.com.

1. The City Commission approved the proposal by the A|D Creative Group of Billings, Montana, to rebrand the Dodge City Convention and Visitors Bureau at Tuesday night's meeting. The Commission authorized the City Manager to sign the agreement pending the City Attorney's review. The purpose of the rebranding project is to develop and implement a strategically-driven destination brand that represents Dodge City, Kansas. The intent is to develop the appropriate verbal and visual messaging to be used in all aspects of promoting Dodge City as a destination.

During the meeting, the Commission also approved the appointments to the City's advisory boards and commissions, rejected the bid for the costs of the Green Hills O'Ford and Trail Street drainage improvements and directed staff to rebid the project, approved bid for architectural services for the recycling building, as well as the approval of a memorandum of understanding for the upgrade of water services at 908 Rath Ave.

2. The Dodge City Fire Department brushed up on their technical rope rescue skills as a part of their training this week. Personnel worked on specific rescue knots, patient packaging, mechanical advantage systems and rappelling to make sure that they are ready to perform this type of rescue at any of the grain elevators or other industrial facilities where high angle or confined space rescue situations may occur. This type of incident is considered a low frequency high risk operation in the fire and rescue services so it is important to train throughout the year to remain proficient.



3. City and Main Street staff, along with various community representatives, met this week with Kate Van Steenhuyse, the South Central & Southwest Regional Consultant for the Kansas Creative Arts Industries Commission. During the visit, Ms. Van Steenhuyse shared information on the various funding programs available through the state and had an opportunity to become more familiar with performing and visual arts in Dodge City.

4. City and United Wireless Arena staff met with representatives from the High Plains Youth Hockey Association. The group discussed the outcome of the 2019-2020 season and plans for 2020-2021. They also explored possible solutions to help extend the number of dates available to utilize the ice.
5. City staff and representatives from the Friends of the Zoo continue to meet and work on the Wright Park Zoo Master Plan Implementation project. Watch the City and Friends of the Zoo Facebook pages for more information.
6. The Dodge City Police Department has been setting up informational nights at different locations in town to answer questions about pay, benefits and what it's like working for the Dodge City Police Department as part of recruitment efforts for the department. This week Corporal Boron and Corporal Harris, were at Anytime Fitness for the event. The next event will be at the Dodge City YMCA on February 12th. FIRST ANNUAL CONSTRUCTION DAY HELD IN DODGE CITY

Dodge City, KS – High school students from Western Kansas are invited to participate in Construction Day. The Dodge City/Ford County Development Corporation and the Community Housing Association of Dodge City (CHAD) will host the first annual Construction Day on March 5, 2020. Students will tour local construction sites, have lunch at the Dodge City Community College (DC3) and spend time with the Building Construction Technology Program at DC3.

The purpose of Construction Day is to encourage students to view construction as a viable career field and to expose them to the Building Construction Technology Program. “We would love to have 150 students from all over western Kansas participate in Construction Day.” Says Mollea Wainscott, Housing Coordinator for the Dodge City/Ford County Development Corporation. “We have an amazing Building Construction Technology Program at DC3 that we hope to promote through Construction Day.”

Main Street Dodge City Awards Grant to Victory Electric

Dodge City, Kansas – January 17, 2020

Main Street Dodge City is pleased to announce that Victory Electric received a Downtown Special Event Grant on December 9th, 2019 for Parade of Lights & Chili Cook-Off. The Downtown Special Event Grant is aimed at bringing new events to the historic downtown district. The grant is geared towards attracting events that will energize downtown merchants, provide cultural enhancements of the downtown, and brand downtown Dodge City as a place of inclusion, vitality, community, culture and entertainment.

The grant provides matching funds up to \$500 per request to help bring new and emerging events and activities to the downtown area. Events sponsored through the Downtown Special Event Grant are intended to offer a variety of diverse, high-quality activities that provide compelling reasons to visit downtown Dodge City.

The funds from the grant were utilized to help with supplies, chili awards, and VR reality trailer.

During the event Main Street Dodge City provides Santa's House, children of all ages get their picture taken with Santa and receive a bag filled with goodies and promotional items from downtown businesses.
